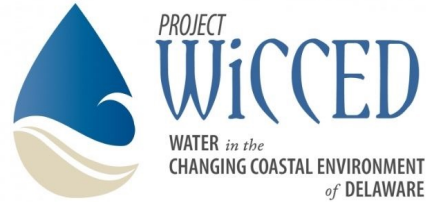


INTRODUCING THE STUDENT COMMUNICATION TEAM
